

# Building A Toad House

This is a fun project for kids of any age to make and enjoy in the yard or garden. They will have fun decorating their toad's house and helping to add it to the yard.

## What You'll Need:

- A clay flower pot, coffee can or similar container
- Acrylic paints and a brush.
- A trowel or other tool for digging.
- Clay pot saucer or tin pie plate.

## Instructions:

- Clean the container and let dry.
- Paint the container and saucer.
- Let the paint dry.
- Find a nice shady and moist spot in the yard or garden. Lay the pot on its side and bury the pot halfway so there is an opening above ground level, then fill the inside with some leaves.
- Place your saucer near the house and fill it with water.

Keep checking your house to see if the leaves have been moved around and if your house has a new resident.

## Alternative:

You can also use the clay pot in the upside-down position and cut a "U" shaped door at the mouth of the pot. This would require power tools. Then you can place it outside and add a few leaves with no need to dig a hole for the pot.
